SESC DIGITAL LIBRARY -We have over 680 audio & 4,095 eBooks titles in our digital library. [SORA](#) is the new platform for Overdrive, it is much more user friendly for the students, and the best part is they don't have to create a separate Overdrive account for the app. They don't even have to know their user name and password when they join from a chromebook. You can still access the classic site at <https://sescut.libraryreserve.com> or on your school website.

TEACHERS: eBooks/audiobooks can be used in the classroom and displayed on interactive white boards and projectors. **Ask me for an Educator Marketplace Account or about Assignments:** Assigned books show up automatically and expire on a due date set by you!

Achievements: Students earn badges by reading books and using Sora app features, increasing engagement.

Notes and Highlights: Students can make notes and highlights within Sora as they read or export them to PDF, CSV, and Google Drive to share with you.

Reading Stats: Sora tracks number of books read, student reading time, time per book, and more. Review one on one to set student reading goals!

Public Library Access: Students can browse, search, and borrow books from the public library to ensure they have immediate access to the content they need.

Grand Log-in: teachers/staff - email, students - S+4 digit student ID, **San Juan Log-in:** sign in using ClassLink. Click on Sora.

KOHA LIBRARY (All DVD's will be fully sanitized and properly quarantined between reservations to maintain safe usage.

- The Koha Library catalog is web-based and can be accessed anywhere with an internet connection. The library hot link can be accessed <http://media.seschools.org/> Type in your Username and Password.
- By logging in, you can then see your personal information, change your password, place items on hold, create lists, post comments, and make purchase suggestions. In the search box, use basic words, title, author, subject, series.
- Check out DVDs for 2 weeks. When logged in you create a list to keep a record of your searches. Click in the box to the left of the title to add to the List. Note: Click on Save to lists, choose which list to save to or create a new list. You can create a Public list or a Private list. You can send your lists to sara@seschools.org.
