

K-12 Professional Development for Teachers and Leaders



General Professional Development Credit

School district partners can develop and teach their own course (e.g., LETRS, classroom management, etc.) based on their individual needs. Just send your proposal and resume to k12inservice@suu.edu for approval. Costs start at **\$21 per credit**. For more information, see **General Professional Development Checklist**.

APPEL & APPEL-SpEd Courses

With APPEL, learners will need to get their PLP from their local school district. APPEL-SpEd learners need to get their PLP from USBE. Once the PLP is completed, learner will email it to k12inservice@suu.edu and register for courses. Courses are **\$100/credit**.

Endorsement Course Credit

Endorsement courses observe USBE requirements. Participants use their transcript credit to apply for endorsement from USBE. These graduate-level credit courses can be taught at the district level by your own instructors for **\$69/course**. They are also taught online for **\$300/course**.

School Leadership Professional Development (SLPD) Certificates

SUU partners with school leaders who need professional development courses through its **SLPD Program**. School leaders may pursue one of four, or all, SLPD certificates: (1) Strategic Stakeholder Operations; (2) Organizational Leadership; (3) Instructional Leadership; and (4) Educational, Political & Community Leadership. These certificates are taken online for **\$100 per credit**. **If you are a school leader, at a Utah Title 1 or "Turnaround" school, you can qualify for a \$300 tuition reimbursement.**

Apply four (4) of your SUU Endorsement, APPEL OR APPEL-Sped Courses (12-credits) toward an SUU Masters of Education (M.Ed.) as *elective credit and have 1/4 of your degree already completed!
